### Proposed Admission Arrangements for Al Hijrah Primary School for 2020/21

The Interim Executive Board is the admissions authority for Al Hijrah Primary School.

As a progressive and inclusive Muslim faith school, the Interim Executive Board welcomes applications from families of other faiths and non-faiths.

### Reception year admission for Al Hijrah Primary School

The admission process is part of the Birmingham City Council's determined scheme for co-ordinated admissions to primary schools.

All applicants are required to complete their home Local Authority's common application form by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020.

Parents will be advised of the outcome of their application on 16<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

The published admission number for the reception year intake will be 60.

All applicants will be admitted if 60 or fewer apply.

If the school is oversubscribed, children will be admitted in accordance with the oversubscription criteria below, once all children with an education, health and care plan, naming the school are admitted.
